## Setting Up a Teacher Account


Log in to SAS Curriculum Pathways by visiting [www.sascurriculumpathways.com](http://www.sascurriculumpathways.com) and entering the generic faculty/staff user name and password for your school.

- If you do not know your school's login information, check with your SAS Curriculum Pathways Coordinator.
- After logging in with your school's generic faculty/staff user name and password, you'll be prompted to create a personal teacher account. During setup, you will:
  - Provide your individual e-mail address.
  - Create a user name and password containing a minimum of six letters and/or numbers and no punctuation or spaces. User names and passwords are case-sensitive.
  - Respond to a verification e-mail within seven days of receipt.
